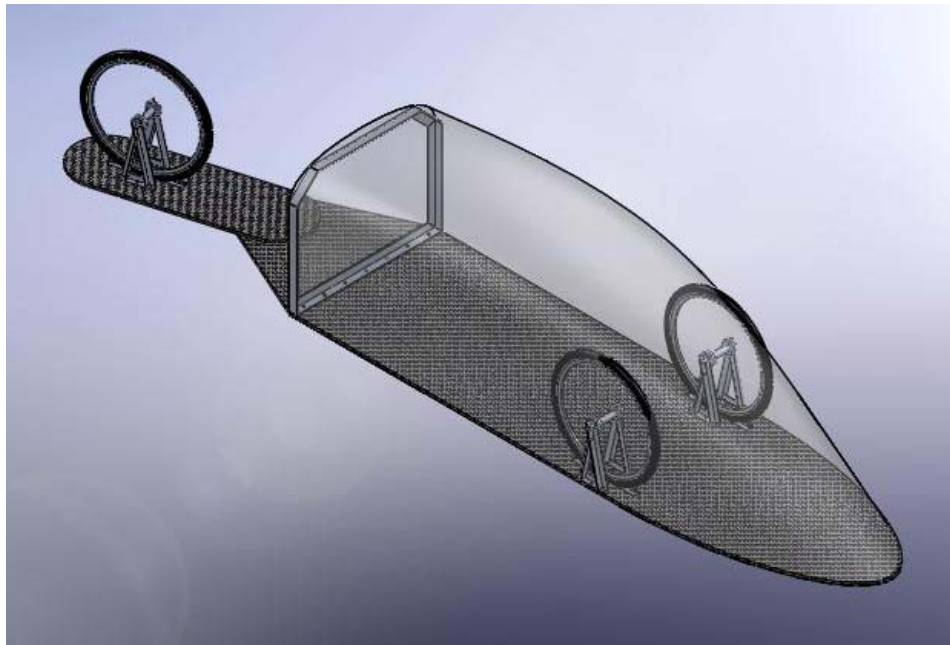


Arizona State University Society of Automotive Engineers 2009 Supermileage Team

What is Supermileage?

The SAE Supermileage competition challenges teams of college students from around the world to design and build a single passenger vehicle capable of traveling a 9.6 mile course while consuming the least amount of fuel. Points are awarded based on vehicle design and achieved fuel efficiency. The record to beat, set by Université Laval at the 2008 competition, is 3169 mpg. The 2009 competition will be held June 4-5 at the Eaton Corporation Proving Grounds in Marshall, Michigan.

What is SAE at ASU?

The Society of Automotive Engineers Student Chapter at ASU exists to provide its members opportunities to gain broader insight into the engineering profession by sponsoring meetings which will bring practicing engineers to the campus, arranging field trips to research and engineering establishments, sponsoring student projects of engineering interest, and participating in local SAE Section activities.
