The Arizona State University Chapter of Tau Beta Pi, The National Engineering Honor Society will award a scholarship of \$500 to an ASU College of Engineering and Applied Sciences Student. If you have any questions, please contact us at tbscholar@asu.edu.

A. Eligibility

1. You must be a full-time student at ASU for the 2004-2005 school year. A full-time student is defined as being enrolled at least 12 semester hours.
2. You must have completed Intro. to Engineering (ECE 100) and at least Calculus I by the end of the 2004 Spring semester.
3. You must have no more than 64 credit hours by the scholarship deadline.
4. You must have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA.

B. Submission of Application

1. Deadline is May 30, 2004.
2. Application shall include the following:
 - a. Unofficial transcript(s) showing the grades you earned in ECE 100 and Calculus (at least Calculus I; transcript can show a higher-level class than Calculus I.)
 - b. Completed TBP Scholarship application form.
 - c. Answer the following questions in 200 words or less:
 - 1) Why do you wish to become an engineer?
 - 2) What are your other interests outside of school (i.e. hobbies, service activities, athletics, etc.)?
3. Your FAFSA must be on file at the Student Financial Aid Office.

C. Selection of Scholarship Winners

Winners will be notified in writing by July 30th. Announcements will also be made at a TBP chapter meeting and a news release will be submitted to the college news media.

E. Payment of Award

The award shall be made in two payments to the student's ASU account in the amount of \$250 each at the beginning of the following fall and spring semesters.

F. Miscellaneous

The scholarship winner will be invited to attend his or her honors convocation. A representative of the ASU Chapter of Tau Beta Pi, the National Honor Engineering Honor Society will present the winner with a certificate.
